
Minutes of the Annual Meeting
Atlanta, Georgia
April 5, 1990

Members Present: George Davis, Pat Dewalt, Judy Egelston-Dodd, Ed Keller, Harry Lang, Greg Stefanich, Catherine Yeotis

1. Approval of the minutes of the 1989 meeting:
There were no minutes taken, however, Charles Coble, George Davis, and Bob Gotwals were present.
2. New Business:
 - A. Election of Secretary/Treasurer: Bob Gotwals resigned as secretary/treasurer. George Davis was elected secretary/treasurer for one year to re-establish the on-going operation of the SHA.
 - B. Newsletter Editor: Bob Gotwals resigned as newsletter editor and publisher so George Davis agreed to publish and mail the newsletter and edit the first issue for the fall of 1990. Greg Stefanich agreed to edit the next two newsletters, one to go out in the winter and the other late spring 1991.
 - C. President-Elect: Greg Stefanich was elected President-Elect and will begin his two-year term as President at the 1991 annual meeting.
 - D. There was much discussion about the in-activity of the SHA after the resignation of Ben Thompson as secretary/treasurer/newsletter editor. Bob Gotwals never did carry out the duties as secretary/treasurer/newsletter editor. George Davis spent about a year trying to find the treasury and the mailing list. He will keep trying as he has not found them yet.
 - E. George reported on the half-day symposium and the luncheon with four disabled scientists that were held at the Atlanta meeting. This is the second year that these two programs were put on by SHA, and they both were very successful.
 - F. Pat Dewalt and George Davis will work on the SHA programs for the Houston meeting. Rae Ann Wuestman will work on the luncheon. George Davis and Greg Stefanich will work on a major two-day conference

on science for the handicapped for the Boston NSTA meeting in 1992. NSF support will be sought for the Boston conference.
